- To reduce the social isolation of individuals and groups within the community.
- To facilitate and encourage the development of personal neighbourhood networks.
- To provide resources, information and personal support to people within the community.
- To address social inequalities and increase life opportunities for people who are disadvantaged, upholding the principles of equality, access, participation and social justice for all the community, irrespective of religion, ethnicity, race, gender, age, disability and socio-economic status.
- To initiate, organise, sponsor or encourage social, recreation and education activities, seminars, information sessions, workshops and similar activities among all members of the community.
