
## REFUNDS

## JESUIT SOCIAL SERVICES - ECOLOGICAL JUSTICE HUB

We partner with the Jesuit Social Society and their Ecological Justice Hub in Brunswick to deliver lids collected through the Lids4Kids initiative. JSS have the technology at the Hub to melt down the lids and repurpose them into practical products which then go back to the community, saving landfill from thousands of bottle lids that commercial recycling plants cannot recycle. **SNH houses a small portion of the Hub's recycled products**, where all proceeds go back to the Jesuit Social Services so they can continue their sustainability programs and expand their recycling capabilities.


